Sorry to hear that you will be selling your new coach, but sounds like you have found a nice home in Roseville. Of course, you can use us as a good reference on the purchase of the 2002 Allure. We are very happy with the coach and the transaction went very smoothly right from the beginning. We had great communication and everything was as you represented it. There were no surprises, and the financial transaction was also trouble free. Country Coach Showcase made a good recommendation based on their inspection of the coach and confirmed that all maintenance had been performed and then some.

We will be spending some time in a 1000 Trails resort in NC and one in Hilton Head SC in June. We were given a membership to 3 campgrounds, the other one is in Wildwood FL, by friends of ours. Gordon,

We are closing escrow today on our new home in Roseville CA -- came across a great deal on a new home -- same town as 1998-2006 but another Del Webb Community adjacent to our previous one. We have two weeks from when we get our key to have a bunch of contractors coming in to add crown molding, repaint the interior to add color, garage cabinets, epoxy garage floor, landscaping in rear, built-in office furniture, etc. Then we take off June 21st for the Pacific Northwest, B.C. and Country Coach Rallies during the last part of August. Then return back to Roseville September 2nd or 3rd.

We will be selling our coach. If we kept it, we would again be gone 9 months of the year! As it is, if we keep our lot in Desert Shadows RV Resort in the Palm Desert area (and put a 5th wheel permanently on it), we would be gone 4-5 months. Have not decided what to do yet with that property.

As before, Country Coach Showcase completed routine maintenance and warranty work (minor items) -- I had a trip previously scheduled through the factory to take care of remaining

items in early May, but cancelled it after all of my warranty issues were handled at the Tucson Rally in February, factory service offered on my resort site by CC techs who are assigned the winter in the desert, and Country Coach Showcase. They just have the factory recall on the ICC and side marker lights (change from 5 amber to 3 amber, and add side lights) to do -- which we will do next week.

Can I use you as a reference for your happiness (I hope) with the 2002 Allure, how well the financial transaction worked, Country Coach Showcase recommendations/review?

Ideally, we hope to close any deal right after September 1st when we return to Roseville. If they want to take possession at the Rally, guess we would load a rental truck and return to our home in Roseville. If they insist on mid-July, then we will have to skip B.C., and they would get our Rally tickets.
